SWINE FLU PREVENTION

What can I do?

IAQ/IH

1. Wash your hands frequently (15-20 seconds) with soap and water.

OSHA/EPA Compliance 1. Wash your hands frequently (13 20 seconds) with soup and water

Phase I/II Soils Groundwater 2. Use Alcohol-based hand sanitizers; rub hands together until the gel is dry.

Hazardous Materials 3. Use sanitary wipes (such as Clorox wipes) to disinfect surfaces in your home, business, car, etc. Virus germs can live up to 2 hours or longer on surfaces such as phones, door knobs, keyboards, desk/tabletops, etc.

Brownfields Disaster Damaged Buildings 4. Cover your mouth when coughing or sneezing. Don't just cover with your hand. Use a handkerchief, tissue or clothing. This virus is spread from person to person; affected persons may be able to infect others 1 day before symptoms develop and up to 7 days or more after becoming sick.

Historical Preservation 5. Stay home when you have flu-like symptoms.

6. Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

- 7. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth; germs are spread this way.

Remediation Restoration Contact your doctor upon first appearance of symptoms. A nasal swab can determine if you are infected. The CDC recommends the use of *Tamiflu or Relenza for treatment*. These are available by prescription from your doctor.
